Dear Kindergarten Families,

Welcome to *The Teunis G. Bergen, Elementary School 9*, World of Kindergarten. At this time we are pleased to inform you that your child's teacher for the 2018-2019 School Year will be:

As you and your child embark on this wonderful and exciting journey of knowledge and partnerships, you will discover that our philosophy of servicing the **Whole Child** strengthens our commitment to ensuring that each child is **safe**, **healthy**, **engaged**, **supported and challenged**. Kindly note that your child's first day of school will be Wednesday, September 5th. Kindergarten students will attend from 8:20 am to 11:30 pm on September 5th. Commencing on Thursday, September 6th there will be a full day of school for your child. He or she will attend school from 8:20 am to 2:40 pm.

Please review the enclosed **Arrival & Dismissal Procedures notice for the 2018-2019 School Year.** This document will serve as your guide during your entire Kindergarten experience. Kindly remember that our school day begins at **8:20 am**, and ends at **2:40 pm** (Monday thru Friday). Students and parents are encouraged to utilize the pathway leading from the stairs at the St. Marks Ave entrance to enter through the door adjacent to the cafeteria (it will be labeled for your guidance to each of the following classrooms: **B1, B3, B5, B7, B19, and B21**.) We ask that you follow the procedures for dismissal as outlined in the **Arrival and Dismissal Procedures** document, and that you honor our Arrival and Dismissal times daily (Mon-Fri). Parents, we strongly encourage you to pick up your child on time since our entire staff will have MANDATORY conferences immediately following dismissal on Monday and Tuesday each week.

Your child's teacher will have his/her name listed on an attendance sheet for a smooth transition upon arrival on the first day of school. Parents are invited to stay with their child's class from 8:20 am to 9:30 am. During that time, your child's teacher will provide you with schedules, and other pertinent details regarding your child's year in Kindergarten.

At 9:30 am, parents will join the Administrative Team and the PTO in the school's auditorium for a brief orientation (see enclosed flyer). All Kindergarten students will be dismissed at 11:30 am on Wednesday, September 5th.

Afterschool Academies:
