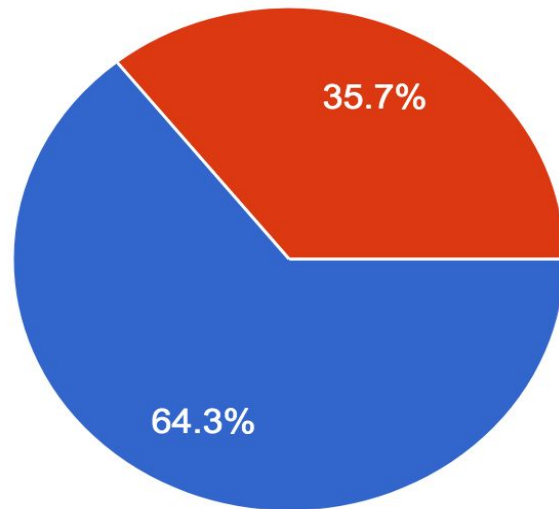

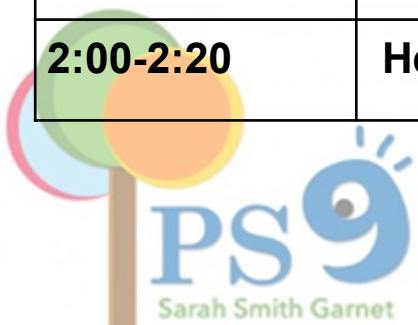

Design of Classrooms



After-School Update

At this time, the only way we can provide after-school is to blend cohorts which is against the guidance.

There isn't enough staff to cover student ratios lower than 9 students, but depending on the cohorts & sign up, afterschool cannot guarantee cohort fidelity to keep students safe.
