

PS9 NYC Student Email, Meets, Classroom

Introduction

The DOE created student email accounts for every single NYC Public School student, including 3K and Pre-K students.

Please note that PreK families have been sent a separate email from Charmaine as their DOE accounts will not be completed until after the 1st day of school - this document currently (9/15/20) pertains to Kindergarten - 5th Grade families

PS9 learners will be using these email accounts this year (and will not be using the @PS9Brooklyn.org email accounts used last year.)

You will need to log into your students' account to access your teacher's Google Classroom, as well as log into Google Meets virtual meetings - **including Orientation on 9/16/20, 9/17/20 and 9/18/20!**

How to Access Your Student's New DOE Email Address

STEP ONE: Identify your students OSIS ID and new DOE email address.

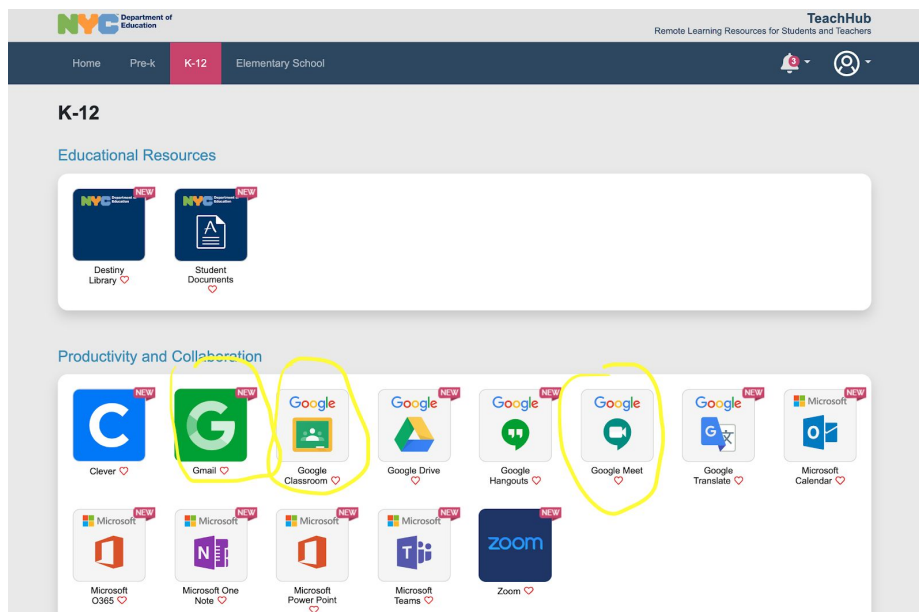

STEP FOUR: Log into TeachHub, click [here](#) - do not enter in the full email address, but just the User Name (ex: ramonaq9 - not ramonaq9@nycstudents.net) in order to log-in.

STEP FIVE: Once you are logged into TeachHub, click on Google Classrooms to begin accepting teacher's invitations to join. You will also see the Icons to Gmail and Meets, which will be frequently utilized.



Once logged in to TeachHub initially, you can access it directly by clicking on www.nycstudents.net moving forward.

How to log into Google Classroom Directly (i.e. not via TeachHub):

1. Visit [Classroom.Google.com](https://classroom.google.com)
2. On the upper right side, hover your mouse over “Sign In” and choose “Google Classroom”
3. At the next screen, type your child’s username **including** @nycstudents.net
4. At the next screen (DOE site), typer Username **without** @nycstudents.net and your password and click “Log In”
