Hello Parents of Pre-K 1,

Welcome to Remote Pre-K! I have made a list of items you should have at home to engage in our Pre-K curriculum.

Please make sure you have these materials at home if possible:

- Primary Paper (wide lines with dashes in the middle) with a place for a drawing. This can be in a notebook or separate pages. Here is a link to a sample:

- A folder to keep your child's work in.
- Various writing tools- crayons, large pencils, markers, dry erase markers, and a black sharpie.
- Stapler and staples for adults to use to create books (optional).
- Construction paper in various colors (Optional- including skin tones).
- Glue and/or glue sticks.
- Child sized scissors (if your child is lefthanded, they have scissors especially for this).
- A ruler in inches only (This can be printed up from our Pre-K google classroom).
- A printer with ink.
- Printing paper.
- Headphones for privacy if you wish (optional).
- A small dry erase board or a page protector to use as a dry erase cover for papers. You can also use a ziplock bag or laminate if you have one available.
- Books- a variety of non-fiction and fiction. These can be obtained from the library for free. A list will be posted on our google classroom before each theme begins.
